The Angels Over Sandpoint – a brief introduction...

When long-time resident, Kathy Pelland was killed by a drunk driver on the Long Bridge in 1977, hundreds of people turned out for her memorial. In sharing stories and recollections, a particular line was repeated over and over again: “Kathy helped me when...”

And the line about “helping” was paired with the telling of what a friend she had been regardless of time or circumstance. Kathy laughed a lot, worked really hard and never let a person down. She inspired a group of friends to carry on in her spirit, and The Angels Over Sandpoint was born.

The Angels Over Sandpoint decided their mission was to continue the work of those who had inspired them. Recognizing the value of living here, of knowing one’s neighbors and lending a hand when the need arises, is directly related to the formation to The Angels Over Sandpoint.

The Angels have staged various fund-raising activities to benefit local people caught between the cracks. The group has helped with a large assortment individuals in need from arranging and cooking meals, to cleaning homes for disabled citizens, providing transportation for those receiving chemotherapy treatments, providing orthotics when funds just weren’t available, The Angels have contributed to local citizens with a wide range of varying needs.

In joining with The Festival at Sandpoint, The Angels Over Sandpoint seek to encourage the youth of our community to excel in the arts. This year our scholarship will focus on writing. Future years focus will include: 2011 Visual arts, 2012 Dance & Theater and 2013 Vocal. The successful applicant is a high school student in Bonner County, including private and home school, who has a primary focus in the arts. The winner will be notified by May 7th and will be presented with their scholarship check at the Festival Family Concert, August 8th, 2010. The winner this year will also have the honor of their written piece to be published in the Family Concert Program as well as in local publications.

## Scholarship Criteria and Guidelines

**Amount of Scholarship:**               **\$1,000.00**

You may use funds for any writing workshops, tutoring/tuition

**Eligibility:** Open to all Bonner County high school students, including private and home school.

**Deadline for Application:** Written applications are to be postmarked by **April 16, 2010**. Please mail your completed application to: Kathy Andruzak, 635 Erie Street, Sandpoint, ID 83864. Any applications postmarked or received past April 16th will not be considered.

**Interview/Portfolio Presentation:** We will contact all applicants to schedule an interview to take place at the Sandpoint Events Center from April 26-30.

**Award Presentation:** The winner will be notified by May 7, 2010 and will be presented with their scholarship check at The Festival at Sandpoint's Family Concert, Sunday, August 8, 2010.

### **Criteria:**

1. **Written Application:**

- Submit written application in type written form. You may reproduce the application on your computer.

2. **Attachments:** In order to be considered you must include:

- Copy of your Transcripts
- Two letters of Recommendation (one **MUST** be from an English teacher). Please, no letters from family members.

3. **A Written Piece of 1,000 words.**

This written piece must be at least 1,000 words on the topic "What inspires you?...i.e., What gets you out of bed every morning, what keeps you going throughout the day, what do you dream about at night?" Your piece can focus on any or all aspects of this topic.
